Southwestern Milestones Series Edward Holslag, 1922

"In the Beginning", "The Pioneer" and "The Round Up" were painted by Edward Holslag and were initially displayed in El Paso's First National Bank in 1922. All three paintings have been displayed in the airport since the 1950s



The River/FI Rio: 2 Both Sides, No Sides

Mitsumasa Overstreet, Bobby Byrd and Sasha Pimentel, 2016

The terrazzo floor artwork was designed by El Paso artist Mitsumasa Overstreet in collaboration with local poets Bobby Byrd and Sasha Pimentel.

La Placita Ceiling Mural 3 Cesar Lujan, 2003

This map-style mural illustrates many historical points of interest throughout our regional trade area made up of Texas. New Mexico and northern Mexico.

75th Anniversary Commemorative Mural

4 Danny Martinez, Leo Zepeda, Jesse Reyna and Joe Lugo, 2003

Individual tiles hand set by mural artisans create this piece that commemorates El Paso International Airport's 75th anniversary. It depicts the historic missions of the Paso del Norte region.

5 Chris Stevens Meister, 1984

This mural depicting El Paso's aviation history includes illustrations of visits from Charles Lindbergh and Amelia Earhart. The 34x7 ft. art piece also showcases Varney Airlines, which was first started in El Paso and later became Continental.

6 John Sherrill Houser and Ethan Taliesin Houser, 2006

This 36 ft. tall monument was created by sculptor John Sherrill Houser and associate sculptor Ethan Taliesin Houser of the XII Travelers Memorial along with a crew of five master craftsmen over a six-year span in Mexico City.

Upon entering either elevator within the entrance of the car rental facility, you are immediately greeted by panoramic photography of the city and its surroundings.


Art Windows of El Paso Gallery

A total of 45 glass panels with designs derived from Indian motifs found in the airport make up this installation suspended from the Concourse B ceiling.



River Spirit Mitsumasa Overstreet, 2013

Inspired by the Rio Grande River that runs through the Paso del Norte region, this terrazzo floor installation spans the airport's 10,000 sq. ft. baggage claim area and includes medallions engraved with El Pasoans' best memories about the city.





Wall Of Giants (Sixth Edition) Tim Hanlon

III IIM Hanio

Originally installed at the El Paso Museum of History, this piece is the sixth edition of the Wall of Giants exhibit. The artwork measures over 18 ft. wide and 7 ft. high and includes LED backlighting. Wall of Giants is a tribute piece that pays homage to the service and sacrifice of Ft. Bliss soldiers.
